## From the Pastor's Desk



The advent of July brings us to the heart of summer- a time known for enjoying the outdoors, going on vacations, picnics, and visiting family and friends. I hope you have ample time to take in all the refreshing opportunities that summer brings to us! By the way, don't forget about attending worship. We continue to follow our regular summer schedule: 8:30a.m.- Contemporary Worship; 10:00a.m.- Traditional Worship.

By now you have probably heard that, unfortunately, my lymphoma has returned. Before a new treatment plan could be laid out by my oncologist, it first had to be determined if my cancer had morphed and learned how to hide from the CAR-T cells that were injected into me last September, or the other possible development- did the CAR-T cells disappear from my bloodstream? The former scenario would have carried a more challenging prognosis than the latter. I'm relieved to say that, in fact, after testing one of my blood samples, it has been determined that for whatever reason the CAR-T cells no longer exist in my blood. This could be due to the fact that when the CAR-T cells were given to me last year that the cancer was so extensive the CAR-T cells entirely spent themselves in their battle with the lymphoma. Fortunately, the company that made my CAR-T cells also made a second dose which they placed in liquid nitrogen last September. This back-up dose will be flown from Seattle, WA to Massachusetts General Hospital and probably be injected into me sometime during the second week of July. For this procedure I will have to be hospitalized for a number of days. My oncologist is hopeful that this second treatment will suffice but, additionally, he is also weighing the possibility of transplanting another immune system into me should I achieve a complete remission after receiving the second dose of CAR-T cells. It is also hoped that since my present level of cancer is not as extensive as last September, that there should be plenty of CAR-T cells remaining to stand vigil against any new outbreaks of lymphoma.

At the most recent semi-annual Congregation Meeting which was hosted at LCOR on Sunday, June 11, a motion was made to grant me a sabbatical for most of the summer months in order to rest and recharge following my recent health challenges. When I learned of my lymphoma's return, and knowing that I would now spend more days in the hospital, I agreed to take a month long sabbatical. I am most grateful to the congregation for approving this motion! You have been so gracious and understanding during my recent health crisis. Please know of my immense appreciation for your compassion and support. I do not know exactly when I will begin my month long sabbatical but at this point I believe it will entail most of the month of July. I am happy to report that Prs. Alan Grant and Michael Fruth will preach and lead worship during my absence. These two clergymen have been such a blessing to us! I thank them for their willingness to always be of great assistance!

I continue to ask for your prayers during this important summer in my life. I cannot achieve anything without God's daily presence and sustenance.

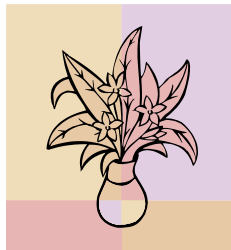
## Flowers for the Altar

If you'd like to put flowers on the altar, simply sign up on the large flower chart on the bulletin board in the hallway leading to the education wing.

They may be given in honor of someone, in memory of someone, an event (anniversary birthday etc.), or simply to the glory of God! If the flowers are being given in honor or memory of someone, please write that on the flower chart. **If no reason is stated on the chart then flowers will be given to the "Glory of God."**

You must sign up a minimum of 7 days in advance. Flower arrangements are **\$35 each**. Please place your payment in the offering plate and be sure you designate the payment as "altar flowers."

These flowers belong to you, after the flowers adorn the altar area for both services, please take your flowers home.



## Receiving E-Mail Newsletter

If you are interested in receiving the newsletter by e-mail rather than the regular mail, please sign up on the E-Mail signup sheet on the bulletin board, or leave a note on the secretary's desk (providing your name and e-mail address). For those of you concerned with computer viruses, the church computer is updated and checked weekly and all e-mail addresses are kept confidential. The e-mail bulletin is sent out to all as a blind copy so if it is forwarded the only email address that is seen is the church's.
